TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to MASSAPEQUA SC to hold a tournament
 or games at Massapequa S.C. MASSAPEQUA PARK NY
 (Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of MARCH 11-12, 20 23, we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate and on Umbrella Liability Policy with minimum limits of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by _____

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form (paper or electronic). These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official at all times.

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: _____ There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

**ALL CHECK-INS/REGISTRATIONS ARE ONLINE VIA GOT SPORT
THERE WILL BE NO ONSITE/GAME DAY CHECK-IN**

CHECK-INS: PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTRUTIONS CAREFULLY

- Check-ins/registration are due by the Sunday before the tournament Kicks off. Instructions for check in can be found below: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY
- Please note that a player can ONLY play for ONE team throughout the tournament**.

***Exceptions will be made by the tournament committee only where there are injuries and only for players in the same club. Players will still be required to be the correct age. Players that are rostered on "A" teams will not be permitted to play on lower seeded teams.*

- US YOUTH SOCCER TEAMS NEED TO PROVIDE
 - One copy of the State Approved Roster
 - A copy of each US Youth Soccer Player Passes (Only front must be copied)
 - A copy of each guest players US Youth Soccer Player Passes (Only front must be copied)
 - Permission to Travel Form if required by USYS teams, including Region 1. Check with your state association for the appropriate form.
- US CLUB SOCCER NEED TO PROVIDE
 - One copy of the US Club Roster
 - A copy of each US CLUB Players Passes (Only front must be copied)
 - A copy of each guest players US Club Player Passes (Only front must be copied)
- Player cards, rosters and med forms must be available at field if requested. Failure to produce any or all documents if requested at game time, will result in a forfeit of all games.

ONLINE CHECK IN PROCESS INSTRUCTIONS - UPLOADING TO GOT SPORT

NOTE: The GotSoccer platform is no longer being used for MSC events.

Gather the respective documents (Team Roster, Player Cards, Medical Release/Player Waiver) that you will need for the Online Check In process.

Begin by scanning and creating a separate PDF for each document file, as they will be uploaded separately.

Please use appropriately descriptive names (for example: ROSTER, PLAYER PASSES, MEDICAL RELEASE) so you will know which files to upload. Please be sure to combine all the player passes (alphabetical order) into a single pdf. TOURNAMENT RULES

ROSTERS: Only properly registered players, appropriately uploaded via the on-line check-in process, and approved by the tournament committee, are eligible to play.

ROSTER SIZE MAXIMUMS:

U9 – U10 = 14 U11 – U12 = 18 U13 – U19 = 22

GUEST PLAYERS: A team may use up to Five (5) guest players, but any team utilizing loaned players is still limited to the player roster maximum based upon age groups.

Teams may only use guest players that are registered with the US Soccer (USSF) youth affiliate their club/team is registered with (i.e., US Youth Soccer teams may only take guest players registered with US Youth Soccer, US Club Soccer teams may only take guest players registered with US Club Soccer, ETC.).

Of Players On Field:

U9 – U10 = 7 v 7 U11 – U12 = 9 v 9 U13 – U19 = 11 v 11

NUMBER & LENGTH OF GAMES:

Please see the individual, approved *Application to Host* listing the Minimum # and Length of tournament games for each age/gender group.

The tournament committee reserves the right to modify these based upon circumstances which are beyond the tournament committee's control (i.e., weather related delays, etc.)

If an injury occurs during the game delaying the game, no time will be added.

IF a bracket has a Semi-Final or Final game, which are tied after regulation, teams will immediately proceed to play to play two (2) 5-minute, golden goal, periods. If a tie still exists after overtime halves, FIFA Penalty Kick will determine the winner. Penalty Kicks will immediately follow game.

RULES OF PLAY

FIFA Laws of the Game will apply as modified by US Youth Soccer and ENYISA as noted, described below:

BALL SIZE: U9 thru U12 Use #4 size ball U13+ Use #5 size ball

Unless supplied by the tournament, the designated HOME team will supply match ball(s) as requested by the assigned match referee.

HALF TIME: Half Time will no more than five (5) minutes duration.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Free substitution will be allowed on any stoppage of play with the permission of the referee.

PLAYERS EQUIPMENT: It will be at the Referee's discretion to determine the safety and suitability of player equipment including the wearing of an orthopedic cast or hard brace. Shin guards are mandatory for all players.

COACHING: All Coaches have total responsibility for the conduct of their players, substitutes, friends and spectators at all times [[SEE ENYISA Zero Tolerance Policy](#)]. Coaching from the sideline (giving direction to One's own team on points of strategy and position) is permitted, provided: · No mechanical devices are used · The tone of the voice is instructive and not derogatory · Each coach or substitute remains within 10 yards on either side of the halfway line; · No coach, substitute, or spectator makes derogatory remarks or gestures to the Referees, other coaches, players, substitutes, or spectators; No coach, substitute, or spectator Uses profanity or incites, in any manner, disruptive behavior.

CAUTIONS AND EJECTIONS: A player or coach receiving two cautions (yellow cards) in a single game is considered to have been given an Ejection (red card) for the purposes of Awarding points for the Tournament competition. A player who has been ejected (sent off), Will not be replaced. A player or coach who has been ejected will not return for that game and will not be allowed to participate in the next scheduled game. A player or coach who is Ejected for violent conduct or serious foul play may be subject to further sanctioning. Any player or coach who assaults a referee will be expelled from the Tournament.

SUSPENDED AND TERMINATED GAMES: If in the opinion of the game officials, if a game must be suspended for any reason the game may be resumed but is subject to being ended not less than five (5) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the next game. If in the opinion of the game officials, a game that is terminated for misconduct of players, bench coaches, or spectators, the offending team could be suspended from further play and forfeits that game and all remaining games. All previous points earned remain as played. Additionally, the home league and State Association will be contacted as appropriate.

TOURNAMENT COMPETITION

DETERMINING WINNERS: Teams will be awarded points on the following basis:

Six (6) points for each Win,

Two (2) points for each Tie,

Zero (0) points for each Loss.

One (1) point for each goal scored up to a maximum of Four (4) per game.

One (1) point for each shutout

MINUS ONE (-1) FOR EACH PLAYER OR COACH EJECTED A 4-2 game will be scored as 10 points for the winning team (6 for win, 4 for goals) and 2 points to the losing team (2 for goals).

In the event of a tie in points at the end of bracket play, the winner for advancement to semifinal, or Final or just for placement will be determined as follows:

1. The winner in head-to-head competition. (If there is a 3-team tie, proceed to the next tie breaker)
2. Goal differential, maximum of +/- 4 per game
3. Least Goals Against
4. Most total wins.
5. Most shut outs.
6. If a tie still exists after steps 1 through 5, FIFA Kicks from the Penalty Mark will be taken Fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the Semi-Final game.

NO RULES WILL BE REVISITED

HOME TEAM: The Home Team will be the team which appears first on the game schedule. The Home Team will supply the game ball, unless supplied by the Tournament. The game ball will be subject to Referee approval. The Home Team will be required to switch to alternate jerseys to accommodate a color conflict as declared by the referee. If the Home Team cannot supply alternate jerseys, the Visitor Team will change. The Home Team should be on the Left Bench when facing the field. Teams are on the SAME SIDE. Spectators are opposite the bench areas.

FORFEITS AND BYES: Teams failing to report ready to play within five minutes of the scheduled kick off time. Teams failing to check in at the Mandatory Registration or for taking actions which cause a game to be terminated will forfeit the game(s) 1-0. The winner will be awarded eight points (six for the win, one for a goal, and one for a shut out).

REFEREES: A referee three-man system will be used whenever possible. When a single referee is assigned to a game, each team shall have an adult linesman who is considered a "game official" and shall be neutral and shall not engage in any coaching whatsoever from the sidelines.

REFEREE DECISIONS: Referee decisions are final. The referee may only change a decision on realization that it is incorrect or, at his/her discretion, on the advice of an assistant referee, if he/she has not restarted play.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/CANCELLATIONS: This is a "Rain or Shine" Tournament, and play should be anticipated. If games are canceled due to extreme inclement weather, games may not be rescheduled. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be passed on to all teams that are registered. Under no circumstances will refunds be made because of cancellation due to inclement weather. **REFUNDS:** If the tournament is cancelled before any games are played, 70% of the registration fee will be refunded to each team that was accepted and paid in full, or a credit will be issued for the following year. If the tournament is canceled after any of the games have been played, no refund will be given.

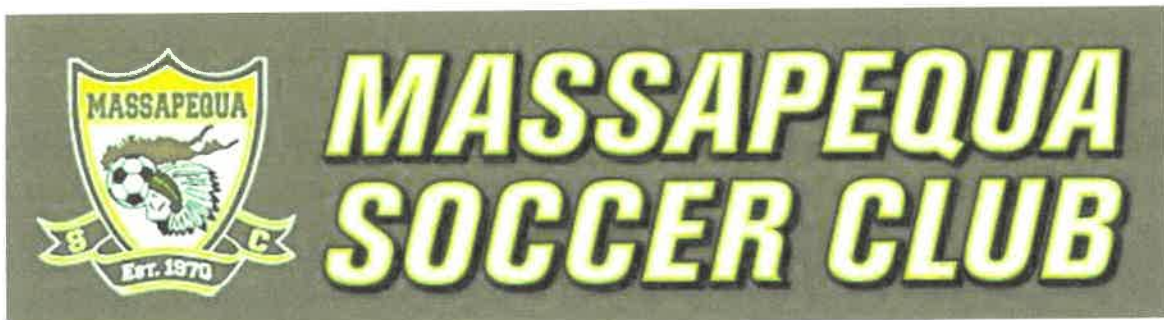
PROTESTS: NO PROTESTS WILL BE ALLOWED. **DISPUTES:** All disputes will be settled by the Tournament Committee, or their designee, and the decision will be final.

OTHER GUIDELINES

With so many teams and fields, it is of the utmost importance to:

- Check your schedule for field and times.
- Be ready to play as soon as the previous game is over. Warm-up in other areas.
- Remove jewelry and check for color conflicts early.
- Move teams off the field as soon as the game is over.
- Do not delay halftime. Be ready to restart as soon as the referee whistles.
- Teams will shake hands at the conclusion of each game.
