TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to to hold a tournament or games at Oceanside Park _____ Oceanside _____ NY _____
(Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of March 30 & 31, 2024 , we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by _____

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form. These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: N/A _____. There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE: We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed. TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

Rules of the Game:

The rules of FIFA will be enforced except as modified herein. All calls are at the discretion of the referee and the decision of the referee is final. The OUSC Tournament/Event Directors reserve the right to decide all matters pertaining to this event including interpretation, review and revision of all rules contained herein. In all cases, the decision of the Directors is final. Coaches are responsible for all players and spectators associated with their respective teams and may be cautioned or ejected for abusive behavior (**ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY STRICTLY ENFORCED**). Only players, coaches and event staff will be permitted on the field and in player bench areas. All other spectators must remain within the designated spectator area.

Eligibility:

Open to registered and insured intramural and/or travel teams of a participating and sanctioned US Soccer youth organization. Photocopies of birth certificates or player passes must be presented for all players, and players on a team must all have passes issued by the same governing body. No player will be permitted to play if they do not have a pass issued by the same governing body as the rest of the players. Each team must supply at check-in, a completed player roster that clearly shows each player's name and jersey number. A player may only play for one team during a session. Any players that are deemed to be ineligible to play will be prohibited from participation in any games during the entire tournament. Three guest players will be permitted per team, but only with proper forms completed, and only if they have a pass from the same governing body as the rest of the players on the team.

Registration & Coaches Meeting:

ALL teams must have a representative present to register their team a half-hour before the session begins (not a half hour before team's first game). All documents required (See "Eligibility" section above) must be presented at that time, and no player will be permitted to play without proper documents. In addition, there will be a coaches meeting, that each team coach or assistant must attend, about 10-15 minutes prior to the start of the session.

No Headers for U11 or Under:

For U11 and under there will be no headers permitted. There will be no intentional heading of the ball in any U11 and younger matches. Any infraction results in an indirect free kick from midfield for opposing team.

Dress Code:

Players may wear either cleats, turf shoes or sneakers. Teams are required to have matching uniforms, and all players MUST wear shin guards, under their socks. No earrings, necklaces, bracelets or jewelry of any kind may be worn. No players will be allowed to play wearing a hard cast or hard brace of any kind. All teams must have an alternate jersey in the event of a conflict, in which case the visiting team must change. All Goalies must wear a jersey that does not match their own team, or conflict with the field colors of the opposing team. Only Goalkeepers will be allowed to wear pants of any kind.

Game Format:

All teams will play a minimum of three 21-25 minute games. The first two games for each team will be in a round robin format, after which standings will be established. The 2nd and 3rd place teams will then play in a single elimination semifinal match, with the winner of that match playing the 1st place team in the final. There will be no stoppage of the clock except for extended player injuries, at tournament officials discretion, no halftime breaks. The semifinal and final matches must have a winner, and those matches will proceed immediately to penalty kicks if tied at the end of regulation. There is no overtime. Each team will be expected to be ready to play five (5) minutes before the start of each of their games.

U9-U10: 14 player max roster/3 guest players allowed – play 6 v 6

U11-U12: 18 player max roster/5 guest players allowed – play 7 v 7

U13-U19: 22 player max roster/5 guest players allowed – play 7 v 7

Substitutions:

All substitutions (including goalkeepers) will be done "on the fly" during play or when a stoppage occurs. "On the fly" substitutions require that the player coming off the field be within three (3) feet of the players bench BEFORE the new player can enter the field. If this rule is violated, the referee at his/her discretion, may award a change of possession at the spot of the infraction (indirect kick).

Tournament Rules re: Out of Bounds and Restarts

The home team will kick off. A kick off is an indirect free kick. All balls used for games will be supplied by the tournament.

There will be throw-ins on out of bounds balls.

Goalie Distribution:

For all u9-10 games: when the goalkeeper has the ball, after obtaining during play or from a goal kick, the opposing team must move behind the build-out line until the ball is put into play. Once all players on the opposing team are behind the build out line (which should be done quickly), the goalkeeper must pass, throw or roll the ball into play, ***punting is not allowed***. After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper and the ball is touched by a player on the goalkeepers team, the players on the opposing team may cross the build out line; thereafter, play resumes as normal. The goalkeeper is not required to wait for the opposing team to retreat to the build-out line before putting the ball into play, but if the goalkeeper does not wait, the opposing team is relieved of their duty to retreat and may resume regular play. If the goalkeeper plays the ball with their feet and carries it outside of the penalty area, the opposing team may cross the build out line as soon as the ball hits the ground outside of the penalty area.

Goalkeeper:

For all U9-10 games: Goalkeepers may **NOT** punt the ball. If a goalie punts, the opposing team will receive the ball at the 18 yard line for an indirect free kick. The goalkeeper may become a field player if the goalie places the ball on the ground and plays the ball with their feet, outside of the penalty area. The opposing team may challenge the ball as soon as it hits the ground outside of the box.

Forfeits:

If a team is not prepared to take the field at game time, they will forfeit the game and be charged with a 2-0 loss.

Point System for Round Robin Play:

Win =6 points,

Tie =3 points

Loss = 0 points

Goals Scored - Each team receives one point for each goal scored (to a maximum of 3 per game per team)

Shutout – 1 point

Any team scoring five or more goals more than its opponent will lose one point for each goal in excess of five. ***THIS RULE ONLY APPLIES TO THE ROUND ROBIN MATCHES, NOT SEMIFINALS OR FINALS.***

OUSC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY TEAM AT THE END OF THE ROUND ROBIN MATCHES AND PRIOR TO THE SEMIFINALS DUE TO CONTINUED/FLAGRANT VIOLATIONS OF THE GOALS AGAINST LIMIT, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THAT TEAM FINISHES IN THE STANDINGS.

Tiebreakers:

The team with the most points in a group will be designated 1st place and receive a bye into the finals. In the event of a tie in points at the end of round robin play, the following system shall apply to determine the standings:

- 1) Winner of Head to Head competition (not used if more than two teams are tied)
- 2) Most Wins
- 3) Least Goals Against (max 3 considered)
- 4) Most Shutouts

- 5) Goal Differential (max 3 considered)
- 6) Running up Score. Any team that wins any game by a 5 or more goal differential shall lose in tie-breaker to any team that has not done so. In the event both teams in a tie-breaker have won games by a 5 or more goal differential, if one team has won more games than the other by more than a 5 goal differential, that team shall lose in the tie-breaker to the team that has done so in fewer games. ***THIS RULE ONLY APPLIES TO THE ROUND ROBIN MATCHES, NOT SEMIFINALS OR FINALS.***

Awards:

First and Second Place Awards will be given, as well as 5 individual awards (offense/defense/goalie/Rudy/Bessie) Awards will be handed out at the brackets closing ceremony, held immediately following the final match. All teams are encouraged to attend, as those awards are usually spread across all the teams in the bracket. A team that does not attend the post game ceremony will not receive any awards, nor will medals/awards be given to a coach or parent that remains for the ceremony but does not have the players with them.

Refund Policy: If circumstances beyond control of tournament management force event to be canceled, at least 70% of entry fee will be returned. No refunds for any other reason.
