### TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to Orange County Soccer Club to hold a tournament  
or games at Hudson Valley Sports Dome Milton NY  
(Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of January 17th & 18th, 20 26, we agree to the following conditions:

**ABIDE BY RULES:** We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

**INVITATIONS:** The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

**HOUSING:** We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

**PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE:** We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate and on Umbrella Liability Policy with minimum limits of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by \_\_\_\_\_

**REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS:** We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form (paper or electronic). These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official at all times.

**ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES:** We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

**CREDENTIALS CHECKS:** We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

**USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES:** We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: \_\_\_\_\_ There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. **AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE:** We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed. We will use the following method(s) of contacting emergency services \_\_\_\_\_

**TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR:** We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

**TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION:** We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

**POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT:** We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:


- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

**Subject: AED Requirement for OCSC ORANGE CUP**

Dear [Tournament Organizers/Committee],

I hope this email finds you well. As we prepare for the upcoming OCSC ORANGE CUP, I would like to emphasize the importance of safety measures during the event. Specifically, we require that an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) be available on-site throughout the duration of the tournament.

**Reasons for Requesting an AED:**

1. **Emergency Preparedness:** Having an AED readily accessible can significantly improve the chances of survival in case of sudden cardiac arrest (SCA).
2. **Player and Spectator Safety:** Our top priority is the well-being of our players, coaches, referees, and spectators. Having an AED on hand ensures that we are well-prepared for any medical emergencies.
3. **Compliance with Regulations:** New York State, as well as Eastern New York Youth Soccer Association (ENYYSA), and local authorities require AEDs at youth soccer events. By providing an AED, you demonstrate your commitment to safety and compliance.

**Logistics:**

- We propose placing the AED in a central location, easily accessible to all participants and staff.
- Trained personnel should be available to operate the AED if needed.

**Assurances:**

- We understand that the safety of the participants (teams, players, coaches, referees and fans) is of utmost importance to [Tournament Name]. Therefore, we kindly request your confirmation that an AED will be present at the tournament venue. **By signing below where indicated, you acknowledge to ENYYSA that you will have at least one operational AED on site throughout the entire tournament. Your acknowledgement will be relied on by ENYYSA and all participants and spectators.**

## 2026 OCSC Orange Cup Tournament Rules

1. Coaches must submit rosters, team passes, medical releases, and guest player forms at least 30 minutes prior to their first game. If any of the items are missing, your player will not be allowed to participate, no exceptions. Premier or select level teams are expected to play up at least 1 level when possible.
2. Non Appearance at the start of your scheduled game will cost your team a forfeit. The team will receive 0 points. The opposing team will receive 2 goals and 3 points.
3. No player may play with a hard cast.
4. There will be no refunds for nonappearance due to inclement weather or any other reason. Refunds will be provided only in the event the Tournament Committee cancels a division due to lack of participation.
5. Coaches and players are responsible before the games to ensure that players are properly equipped (socks over shin guards, proper jerseys, etc.) and are not wearing any jewelry or long pants on field. Each team should bring 2 sets of jerseys. Home team is required to change jerseys or forfeit the game.
6. **NO CLEATS ALLOWED.** Rubber-soled or turf shoes only. Should the referee discover a player or players wearing cleats, the offending player will be asked to leave the field.
7. All rules are F.I.F.A rules except the following outlined below:
8. Number of players on field:
  - U12 and younger: 8v8 (includes keeper)
  - U13-U16: 7v7 (includes keeper)
  - U17, U18, U19 and HS: 6v6 (includes keeper)
9. Substitutions are unlimited and may be made when the ball is out of play or on any stoppage.
10. Kickoffs can be played in any direction. Home team will kick off. Home team is the first team listed on schedule. There is no coin toss.
11. If the ball strikes the ceiling the ball remains in play at the referee's discretion. If the referee determines a restart is required, it will be an indirect kick from the half line.
12. The ball must be put into play from a restart within 5 seconds. If not, at the referee's discretion, the ball will be given to the opposing team for delay of game (throw-in or free kick to opposing team, corner/goal kick switch).
13. On free kicks, goal kicks, corner kicks, penalty kicks and kick-offs, the opposing team must be 7 yards away from the ball.
14. The goal area and penalty area are the same area.
15. Penalty kicks are taken from the penalty mark area for U12 and under; Penalty kicks are taken from the 18 yard line for U13 and up.
16. Any player receiving a yellow card will sit out the remainder of that game and the team will be penalized 1 point. 2 yellow cards accrued will result in an automatic red card.
17. Any player or coach receiving a red card is automatically ejected from the remainder of the tournament and the team will be deducted 2 points and play one player down. Exception: A player red carded for handball violations sits out the remainder of the current game only.

18. There is no off-side rule.
19. Slide tackles are prohibited and result in an indirect kick, and may result in a red card.
20. Games start with a starting horn and end with an ending horn. The games are 25 minutes, giving all teams 2 minutes to exit and enter. Please move quickly on and off the field since lost time will not be made up. Each team will be guaranteed 4 games or 100 minutes of playing time.
21. Scoring: Points will be awarded as follows:
  - Win: 3 points
  - Tie: 1 points
  - Loss: 0 Points
  - Shutouts: 1 point
  - Each Goal = 1 Point up to 3 goals per team per game.
- Forfeits: A team winning a game by forfeit shall be credited with a 2-0 win and 3 points.
  - In case of a tie in the final standing within a division group:*
    - a. Head to head
    - b. Goals allowed
    - c. Goals differential
  - The tournament committee has the sole responsibility of interpreting the rules. The committee's decision is final. No protests will be accepted.*
22. Final games that end in a tie: a sudden-death shootout will begin IMMEDIATELY at the end of regulation. At least 3 different shooters must shoot before a shooter goes a second time.
23. Coaches are responsible for the behavior of their players and fans. Only coaches and players on the playing field. Disruptive behavior may result in a team yellow or expulsion from the tournament and/or facility.
24. Food and drink are prohibited on turf areas. Only food and drink purchased at the Hudson Valley Sports Dome are allowed in the facility. Smoking and spitting are strictly prohibited throughout the facility. Coaches and players are responsible for the cleanliness of their team areas. All garbage is to be placed in appropriate garbage receptacles.
25. The golden ball will be used in the first 5 minutes of the game.

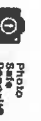
