TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to KOSMOS FC to hold a tournament
 or games at KISSENA PK FLUSHING NY
 (Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of JUNE 20,21 , 20 26 , we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate and on Umbrella Liability Policy with minimum limits of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by _____

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form (paper or electronic). These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official at all times.

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: _____ . There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. 
TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.


POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

Subject: AED Requirement for 30 Years Kosmos Anniversary

Dear [Tournament Organizers/Committee],

I hope this email finds you well. As we prepare for the upcoming 30 Years Kosmos Anniversary, I would like to emphasize the importance of safety measures during the event. Specifically, we require that an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) be available on-site throughout the duration of the tournament.

Reasons for Requesting an AED:

1. **Emergency Preparedness:** Having an AED readily accessible can significantly improve the chances of survival in case of sudden cardiac arrest (SCA).
2. **Player and Spectator Safety:** Our top priority is the well-being of our players, coaches, referees, and spectators. Having an AED on hand ensures that we are well-prepared for any medical emergencies.
3. **Compliance with Regulations:** New York State, as well as Eastern New York Youth Soccer Association (ENYYSA), and local authorities require AEDs at youth soccer events. By providing an AED, you demonstrate your commitment to safety and compliance.

Logistics:

- We propose placing the AED in a central location, easily accessible to all participants and staff.
- Trained personnel should be available to operate the AED if needed.

Assurances:

- We understand that the safety of the participants (teams, players, coaches, referees and fans) is of utmost importance to [Tournament Name]. Therefore, we kindly request your confirmation that an AED will be present at the tournament venue. By signing below where indicated, you acknowledge to ENYYSA that you will have at least one operational AED on site throughout the entire tournament. Your acknowledgement will be relied on by ENYYSA and all participants and spectators.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We appreciate your efforts in ensuring a safe and enjoyable soccer tournament for everyone involved.

TOURNAMENT RULES

General Rules

All Tournament matches will be played in accordance with the "Laws of the Game" as issued by FIFA, except as specifically modified by these tournament rules.

The Tournament Committee's interpretation of these rules shall be final and binding. Decisions of the referees are final and binding.

Registration

All roster changes must be made at the time of registration.

No Card, No Play, No Exception! This applies to ALL players and coaches.

At Initial Tournament Registration all teams must provide ALL of the following documentation:

- Copy of State Approved Roster – we will keep this so do not give us your original roster.
- Copy of the Tournament roster showing all players (including rostered and guest players) that includes player ID numbers AND uniform numbers.
- Primary Player Cards for all players for current year, including Guest Players – All players on the same team, rostered or guest, must use Player Passes from the same governing body.
- Coach Cards for all coaches for current year from same governing body as players.
- Filled out and signed Registration Affirmation document.
- Travel Permit (for out-of-state teams if your governing body requires it).
- Team Contact Sheet (available on Tournament website and at Initial Tournament Registration) including cell phone numbers for a primary and backup contact, as well as the name of their hotel, if relevant, to assist in communications in the event of weather-related issues. The Team Contacts' cell phones must be in operation over the course of the Tournament.
- All teams are responsible for their own insurance.

Pre-Game Check-In Procedures

- Each team must arrive at the field 20 minutes before game time.
- At the referee's signal, each team will come to the center, lining up on their respective side in a semicircle;
- Linesmen will make their appropriate inspections and announcements;
- When asked, captains will join the referee in the center for the coin toss;
- After the coin toss and selection of side/first touch, each team will return to the sideline;
- The game whistle will sound in approximately 1 minute.

Substitutions

Substitutions may be made without limit, with the permission of the referee as follows:

- After a goal has been scored.
- At the beginning of the second half.
- At either team's goal kick.
- At a throw-in for either team.
- In the case of injury to a player, if a substitution is made for the injured player, the other team may also make substitution(s).
- There will be no substitution for a player who has received a red card and has been ordered from the field by the referee.

Referees

The Tournament Committee has made a commitment to use current registered USSF referees (Grade 8 minimum) will apply and to use the USSF three-man referee system for all U13-U18 matches; U8-U12 will use a one-man referee system. This commitment will be carried out wherever possible.

Overtime

Ties will stand in all preliminary rounds. In the event that a division is to be decided by a playoff rather than by points, the game will proceed directly to penalty kicks, 5 per team. The FIFA penalty kick procedures will be used to determine the winner.

Protests

No game protests will be allowed. The referee's decision is final. All other tournament issues, questions, etc., can be directed to the Tournament Committee.

Conduct

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH COACH/MANAGER TO INFORM THEIR PLAYERS AND PARENTS OF THESE GUIDELINES.

Players, coaches and spectators are expected to conduct themselves within the spirit of the game as well as the letter of the law.

Players, coaches or spectators ejected from a game by the referee must leave the field area. Referees will report all yellow/red cards to the field coordinator. Anyone receiving a red card will be ineligible for the next scheduled game. Anyone receiving a red card for fighting will be ineligible for any remaining tournament play.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their team's spectators. Any misconduct by spectators will result in yellow or red carding of the coach(es) responsible.

The Tournament Committee will report incidents of misconduct back to the team's respective League or Affiliation as well as to the New ~~YORK~~ Youth Soccer Association.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to suspend any player, coach, or team from the tournament for unruly conduct.

Games and Score Reporting

Each coach will be responsible for verifying and signing the game report prepared by the referee before the field coordinator leaves the game site and reports the results of the match. The field coordinator is responsible to see that the scores of each game are reported on a timely basis to tournament headquarters. No changes will be accepted once the game report has been filed.

Forfeits or Failure to Show

A team shall be awarded a 10-minute grace period after the scheduled kick off time before the game is awarded to the opponent. If the minimum number of players are present as defined below, the game may not be delayed past the scheduled starting time.

For 11v11 games, a minimum of 7 players constitutes a team.

For 9v9 games, a minimum of 6 players constitutes a team.

For 7v7 games, a minimum of 5 players constitutes a team.

In no case shall a team that has forfeited a game be declared a division winner. A forfeit shall be awarded as three points for the win. For tie breakers, the score for the forfeit game shall be set as the team's average of goals scored rounded up to the next whole number, against the average of goals given up rounded down to the next whole number.

Determining Division Winners

Unless determined in advance by the Tournament Committee upon notice to all interested teams, there will be no playoff games; division winners for all age brackets will be determined by points. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to implement a playoff to determine a division winner, with the other teams in the division playing a consolation game.

Each team will be awarded three points for a win, one point for a tie and zero points for a loss.

The division winners and runners-up will be those teams with the most points and second most points (or, in the event of a playoff, the winner and loser of the playoff game). In the event that two or more teams are tied for first or second place, the following tie-breaking rules will apply:

1. Head to head competition (does not apply if more than two teams are tied).
2. Goal differential
3. Goals For
4. FIFA penalty kick procedures. To be taken on a designated field at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

Weather/ Refund Policy

The Tournament Director, the Tournament Committee, ³ will not be responsible for any tournament fees and expenses incurred by any team, club or individual if the tournament is canceled in whole or part. In the event the whole tournament has to be canceled, refunds will be issued after tournament expenses are met. The amount of the refund will be at least 70% of the registration fee. For partial tournament cancellations, we will pro- rate discounts towards future events based on games played and after expenses have been met.
