TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to LaGrange Soccer Club to hold a tournament or games at LaGrange Soccer Club / Lagrangerville NY (Hosting Organization) (City) (State) On the dates of Sept. 5th 20 26, we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer Application to Host A Tournament or Games, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer Travel and Tournament Policy and in this US Youth Soccer Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate and on Umbrella Liability Policy with minimum limits of not less than \$5,000,000 per occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form (paper or electronic). These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official at all times.

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer Application to Host a Tournament or Games. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE: We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed. TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

Subject: AED Requirement for *LaGrange Soccer Club/Stringham Park*

Dear [Tournament Organizers/Committee],

I hope this email finds you well. As we prepare for the upcoming *LaGrange Cup* I would like to emphasize the importance of safety measures during the event. Specifically, we require that an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) be available on-site throughout the duration of the tournament.

Reasons for Requesting an AED:

1. **Emergency Preparedness:** Having an AED readily accessible can significantly improve the chances of survival in case of sudden cardiac arrest (SCA).
2. **Player and Spectator Safety:** Our top priority is the well-being of our players, coaches, referees, and spectators. Having an AED on hand ensures that we are well-prepared for any medical emergencies.
3. **Compliance with Regulations:** New York State, as well as Eastern New York Youth Soccer Association (ENYYSA), and local authorities require AEDs at youth soccer events. By providing an AED, you demonstrate your commitment to safety and compliance.

Logistics:

- We propose placing the AED in a central location, easily accessible to all participants and staff.
- Trained personnel should be available to operate the AED if needed.

Assurances:

- We understand that the safety of the participants (teams, players, coaches, referees and fans) is of utmost importance to [Tournament Name]. Therefore, we kindly request your confirmation that an AED will be present at the tournament venue. By signing below where indicated, you acknowledge to ENYYSA that you will have at least one operational AED on site throughout the entire tournament. Your acknowledgement will be relied on by ENYYSA and all participants and spectators.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We appreciate your efforts in ensuring a safe and enjoyable soccer tournament for everyone involved.

Tournament Rules

It is essential that the town's properties, facilities, and neighboring private property be respected. Teams will be required to pay for any property damage caused by their team.

In accordance with FIFA policy, there shall be no dissent between players and/or coaches, and the referee. Questioning a referee's call is considered dissent. Coaches are responsible for the actions of their fans and are expected to demand their support in monitoring and enforcing this policy. A player or coach who receives a red card is automatically ejected from the tournament. A player or coach who receives two yellow cards in a game is out of the game and the following game. A player or coach who receives three yellow cards during the tournament is ejected from the entire tournament. For gross misconduct, the Tournament Director will suspend a player or a coach for the entire tournament. Any coach that receives a suspension will not be permitted to participate as a coach or an assistant for any other age group or team.

NO protests shall be allowed.

Maximum roster size for U8-U10 is 14, for U11 and U12 is 18 and for U13 and up is 22. Teams must be affiliated with the USYA and/or USSF. All premier teams will be required to play up. Team rosters, medical release forms and player passes will be required at the team sign in on the day of the tournament. A maximum of 3 guest players will be permitted. Players may compete for only one team in a division.

Tournament games will be played under FIFA rules with the following exceptions:

- A. Unlimited substitutions at all stoppages with the consent of the referee. All substitutions to be made at the halfway line.
- B. Match duration as described below.
- C. No casts of any type will be allowed to be worn by players, unless approved ahead of time by the tournament director.
- D. Build out lines will be in effect for U10 and younger matches. All jewelry is strictly prohibited.

PLAYER EQUIPMENT: FIFA rules apply. Shin guards are mandatory and must be completely covered by a sock worn over the shin guard.

STARTING TIMES: Teams must register 30 minutes prior to the start of their first game. A team must be on the field at the scheduled start of play or forfeit the game. All matches begin and end on the sound of the refs whistle. Each ref will be responsible for keeping the time on their field.

DURATION OF PLAY: All games will be 45 minutes long. Each team will play 3 games. There will be two 20 minute halves. There will be a 2-minute half time and teams will switch goals. There will be 3 minutes between games. These rules are subject to change as directed by the Tournament Director.

The home team will be listed first on the schedule. The home team will kick off. The visiting team will choose the goal to defend. Each team will bring an alternate jersey. In case of conflict of colors, the home team will change jerseys.

In the event that a playoff system is used, and there is a tie after regulation time, the winner will be decided by two (2) 5-minute overtimes with teams changing goals and no break. A coin toss will determine the team to kickoff. If still tied, the winner will be determined by penalty kicks.

PLAYER PASSES: Player passes will be checked online or at onsite Registration as needed and may be checked prior to any game. However, any coach has the right to challenge any player on any opposing team. The referee must be notified of the challenge prior to the completion of the game and the player and his/her pass will be examined after the game. Any team using an illegal player or one without a valid pass shall receive no points for all previous games. Their opponent(s) shall receive three (3) points for a win. The offending team's league and state association will be notified.

STANDINGS: Each team will be awarded three (3) points for a win, one (1) point for a tie and zero (0) points for a loss. Each team will also receive (1) point for a shutout unless the score is 0-0. Goal Differential will have a max of 5. Please be respectful and try to keep from running up the score on teams. Teams winning a game by forfeit shall be credited with a 4-0 win. Teams will be ranked according to total points earned. In the case of ranking ties, the following criteria will be used to break the tie in the order they are listed:

1. Most Wins
2. Head to Head
3. Goal Differential
4. Most Goals For
5. Fewest Goals Against
6. Most Shutouts

WEATHER: Due to circumstances or conditions beyond its control, the Tournament Committee will not be responsible for loss of any funds due to the cancellation of all, or any part, of this Tournament. In the case of severe weather, the Tournament Director shall be in charge. However, the Tournament Director will consult with the Referee Coordinator, town officials, and monitor weather tools when making any decisions. In the event of lightning, one long blast of an air horn

will indicate that teams should leave the playing field and seek shelter. Play will be stopped for up to 30 minutes following the last visible signs of lightning. Two short blasts of an air horn will indicate players should return to the field. Three short blasts of an air horn will sound.

Coaches are required to bring player cards and medical release forms to every game. AYSO teams should contact tournament director for special instructions. No recreational players will be allowed for insurance reasons.

Players and coaches of each team will sit on one side of the field and spectators from both teams will remain on the opposite side of the field. Players/coaches and spectators will not be on the same side of the field.

If a game is temporarily suspended due to weather, field conditions, or other situations, each team must check with tournament headquarters for further instructions.

The Tournament Director's interpretation of the foregoing rules and regulations shall be final.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to decide on all matters pertaining to the LaGrange Cup.

No alcohol is permitted -all alcohol is strictly prohibited.

No barbeques, stoves or open flames allowed except by vendors.

Park in designated areas only and do not block other cars in. Violators may be towed at owner's expense.

NO Pets are permitted at the sites. The spectator will be asked to leave the location.

LaGrange Soccer Club and the Town of LaGrange assume no responsibility for any injury resulting from participation in this tournament. By accepting these rules and procedures, all participating clubs and players indicated that they carry their own insurance and will hold harmless the LaGrange Soccer Club and the Town of LaGrange.

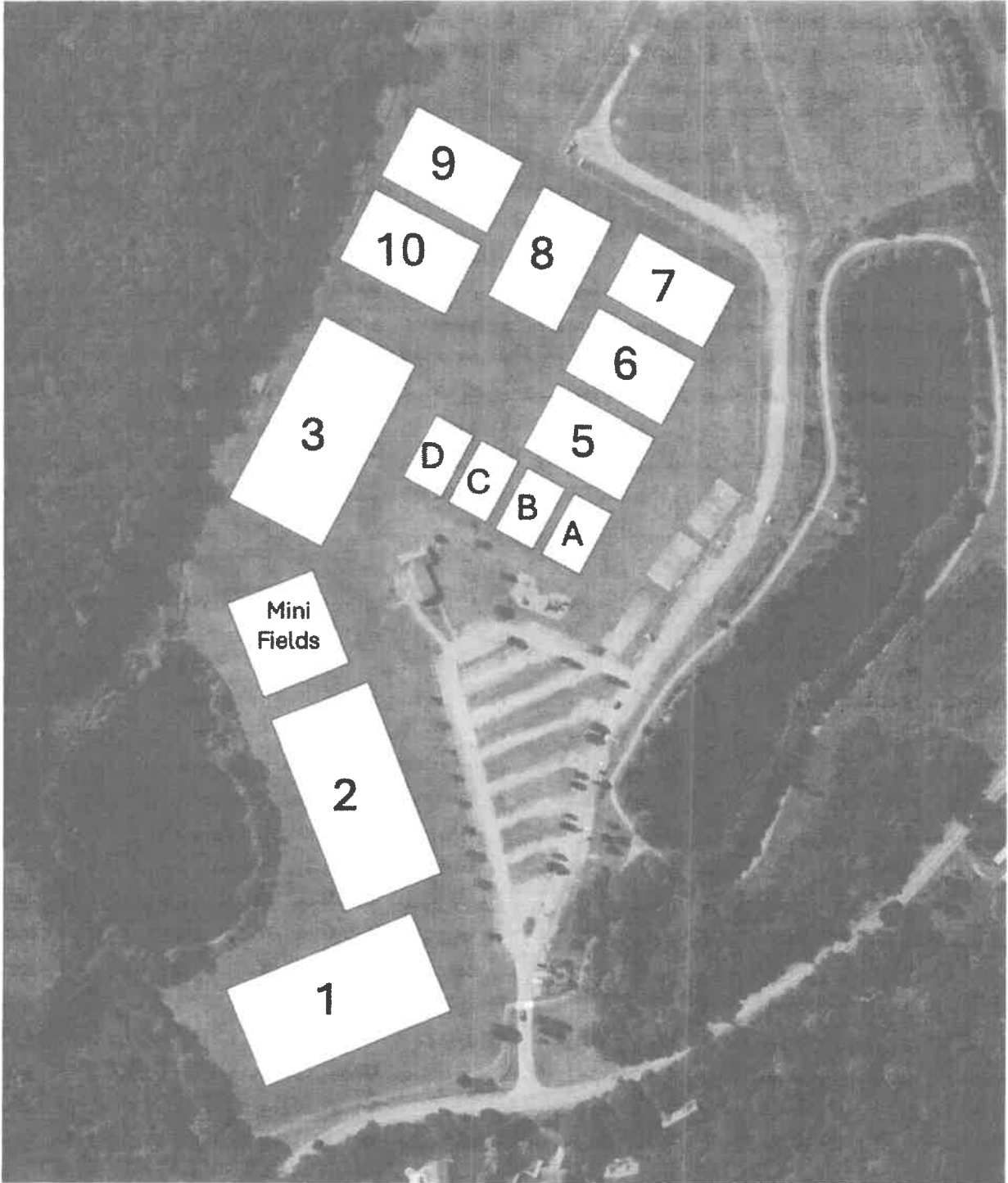
